POSTER SUBMISSION INSTRUCTIONS

Submissions should be a one-page abstract with a title, description, institution, and list of people involved with your poster in PDF file format to info.hbcudsc@gmail.com by **January 14, 2022**. Be as specific as possible in describing what you will demonstrate or display on a poster.

DEADLINE DATES

- **Your submission will be reviewed within 3-5 days after submission, and you will receive an email notification stating your poster approval. Accepted proposals require video poster presentations that will be available for attendee viewing during the 2022 HBCU-DSC Virtual Celebration.**
- **Accepted proposal videos are due January 28, 2022, with the following information:**
 - Faculty advisor name and institution
 - Faculty advisor email address
 - Faculty advisor disclaimer verifying only research and other appropriate content is included in the video presentations.
